

TEDDY BEAR CROSSING SIGNS





You may have seen the Bear Spotting movement that is so fun for making connections. Neighbors put teddy bears in their windows, and children try to spot the bears. It's adorable.

To make sure people know you have a bear to find, it's helpful to put a sign in the window, along with the bear. They can be surprisingly hard to see, especially if they're dark brown. To prove my point, there's a bear hanging in this window next to the sign! You can see his nose if you peek

You may notice that I'm cheating a little, with a bunny, an elephant, and a hippo, along with my bear. I just stuck the sign to the window with a piece of transparent tape. I did print it on cardstock to keep it from curling.



I made six different designs to choose from. There are only five in the picture because I used one in my window! I sure hope people come visit my bear!
