This set is for the sole use of purchasers of my book *Concept Capsules: The Interactive, Researchbased Strategy for Teaching Academic Vocabulary.*

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


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
TO PLAY:

- Divide class into teams of between three and five players.
- The teams take turns responding to clues about or questions.
- Correct answers earn a point, as well as the opportunity to pick a number off of the Zap! Board (or out of the stack of Zap! Cards).
- The student picks a number off of the Zap! Board and earns the value of points on the card drawn.
- If the card that says "ZAP!" is drawn, all points are lost.
- The object is to be the team with the most points once time is up or all of the numbers on the Zap! board have been drawn.







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
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
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


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


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





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
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
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
